1	2025	1245	37	Denmans Lane	Erection of part two storey, part single storey side extension, front extension and rear extension with changes to fenestration and associated landscaping works, including widening existing access.
2	2025	1298	Roslings	Black Hill	Cedar (T1) - reduce crown by 1.5m, reduce low over extended laterals on South and East side by 2m, raise crown to 4m
3	2025	1320	6	Portsmouth Wood Close	3 x multi stemmed ash - fell, 3 x holly - reduce by 1-2m to growth points, multi stemmed hazel trees - coppice.
4	2025	1536	Carriers Cottage	Lewes Road	Replacement of timber windows to the ground floor front elevation with like for like units, replacement of non-matching timber windows to the first floor rear elevation with units to match style of existing property, new 5m depth glazed extension to the rear. (Archaeological Study received 09.10.2024, amended plans received 21.05.2025 and amended DAS and Heritage Statement received 29.10.2024)
5	2025	1388	63/65	Savill Road	Oak - Reduce back to previous cut points (approx 2-3m) and remove all epicormic growth on main trunk.
6	2025	1367	West View House	West View	To reduce the crown by 2m and width by 2m of four trees - Magnolia, Dogwood and two Cherry trees
